Minimum Education & Experience: High School Diploma or GED is required and 1 year of relevant work experience as a CNA preferred.

Certification Requirement: Graduated from a CNA training program. Must hold a current and valid CNA certification in New York.

The ***Certified Nursing Assistant*** will provide essential direct care to adults with disabilities, ensuring their health, safety, and comfort. You will assist with daily activities and personal care while maintaining a positive, respectful, and supportive environment. In addition to CNA responsibilities, the role includes serving as a classroom aide when personal care needs do not need to be addressed. Duties include (but not limited to) providing hand-over-hand assistance, encouraging student participation in classes such as dance, music, theater, and visual art, and completing necessary documentation and classroom support tasks.

The ideal candidate will have a strong commitment to improving the lives of individuals with disabilities and a compassionate approach to care.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities (KSAs):

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Compassionate, patient, and respectful of others' dignity and independence.
- Ability to handle physical tasks, including lifting and transferring participants.
- Knowledge of basic medical procedures and personal care techniques.
- Flexibility and adaptability to meet the changing needs of individuals with disabilities.

Physical Abilities:

- Ability to safely lift, move, and transfer 50 lbs or more, requiring core strength for support and movement.
- Standing, walking, and being physically active for extended periods, using back and stomach muscles.
- Constant movement in rooms, hallways, and workspaces, including bending, crouching, and reaching.
- Good vision (close, distance, color, peripheral) and hearing to understand participants and observe details.

Responsibilities:

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Provide personal care and assistance to adults with disabilities, including assistance in the bathroom, feeding, and mobility assistance.
- Monitor and report changes in the health or behavior of participants to supervisors or medical professionals.
- Assist with medication administration and ensure proper documentation.
- Maintain accurate records of patient care and treatment plans.
- Provide emotional and social support to enhance the well-being of participants.
- Promote independence and dignity by respecting the personal choices of participants.
- Ensure a clean and safe environment for participants and assist with housekeeping duties as needed.
